EXAMPLE



The table below contains examples of risks that an operator of a small vessel may identify when undertaking a risk assessment for their vessel operation. These examples are indicative only, they are not intended to be taken as definitive or applicable for any particular vessel or operation.

Capsize	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Drowning • Injury • Exposure to elements • Loss of vessel 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Level flotation • Gear secured correctly • Adequate power • Avoid bad weather • Bilge alarm and pump • Plugs/bungs • Lifejacket worn at all times 	Yes
